#### Who can participate?

Open to all! There are classes for adults and children ages 5+ (you don't have to be a D14 student to participate).

#### When and how long are the classes?

Our 9-week Winter Semester started this week, but it's not too late to register. Most classes are 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. or 3:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. A 4-week session, Arts-in-April will offer FREE classes to everyone.

#### Who teaches the classes?

High quality specialist teachers from D14 and partner organizations that have been background checked by D14.

#### Where are the classes taught?

**Introducing ARTs14** 

**Manitou Springs Elementary** School, Ute Pass Elementary School, Shared and Integrated Learning Center SILC (D14 Admin Building at the rear of the High School), and Manitou Art Center.

#### How does my child get from their school to their class at the SILC?

Students are supervised from the end of their school day until they are collected by their parents/ guardians after class. Transportation is provided from UPES and MSES to the SILC building. Transport is also available, by prior arrangement, from the SILC and MSES back to UPES after class.

#### What is the cost of the classes and are there discounts for multiple classes?

The cost is \$64 per 9-week session, but there are discounts available. Please visit our website for a list of these coupons. The Arts-in-April 4-week session is FREE to everyone.

#### **Does ARTs14 offer Summer Programs?**

Yes! ARTs14 directs the Green Box Arts Camp in Green Mountain Falls for the Green Box Arts Festival. This is a FREE camp for students entering Grades 3 to 7, supported by an ARTs14 grant from the Kirkpatrick Family Fund.

In 2018 we will also be offering two highly popular Manitou Springs Arts Academy camps for Middle and High Schoolers.

Eat.Sleep.Film and 48hr Musical will be offered at a significantly reduced rate for participants, also with the support of the Kirkpatrick Family Fund and under the umbrella of ARTs14.
